POKER-TOURNAMENT-REGLEMENT

1. Registration

To secure your participation in the tournament, we need your binding registration and the payment of the entry fee. (Buy-in). You have the following options:

- at the reception or
- on the Internet: www.spielbank-stuttgart.de

The buy-in (plus credit card fee) will not be refunded in the event of non-attendance at the start of the tournament - except in the cases set out in point II Ziff 1a-c of the General Terms and Conditions.

Each player accepts the applicable rules of the game tournament.

2. Prize money

3. Starting Places

The draw of the starting places takes place before the beginning of the tournament. Paid seats whose holders are not present at the start of the game will be filled with the tournament table-stake from which the blinds will be taken. At the end of the second blind phase, a new player can take over the seat and table-stake against payment of the buy-in. The claims of the previously booked player are thus lost - except in the cases according to point II Ziff 1a-c of the General Terms and Conditions.

4. Absence

If a player is temporarily absent, his hand is folded by the dealer at the beginning of the first betting round and the blinds are called in if necessary, and if the player leaves the table, although he is still actively involved in a pot, his cards remain active until he would have to place a bet. The hand is then folded.

5. Limit increases

The blinds are increased according to a given schedule. The tournament management will decide on further increases.



6. Adjustment of the tables

- If there is a difference of two players between two tables, a player from the table with more players must move to the table with less players.
- As soon as as many participants have been eliminated as at the beginning of the tournament at one table, a table will be closed. Players will be allocated to the remaining tables by drawing lots.
- Players who come from a table that has been closed can join the Big Blind, Small Blind and Button. The only position where you don't get a hand is between Small Blind and Button.

7. Elimination

 If two or more players are eliminated in the same game, the player who lost the game with the higher table-stakes has the better ranking.

8. Deals

- Deals are only possible at the final table.
- For a deal all players still in the tournament participating must agree.
- The first place receives at least 15% of the prize money.

9. Tournament chips

- The chips must always be visible to all.
- The removal or transfer of tournament chips to other players will be penalized with immediate expulsion of the players involved from the tournament.
- The tournament management can sanction the player with a casino ban in both cases.
- The entry fee (plus credit card fee) will not be refunded.

10. Miscellaneous

- Verbal announcements are binding.
- Non-active players are not allowed to comment on a running game.
- If there are situations at tournaments that are not exactly described in the tournament rules, the tournament management (the Floorman) will always make decisions that are characterized by the principle of fairness.
- The Spielbank Stuttgart has the right, with the express consent of the tournament participant, to publish the prize money and his name free of charge.
- Media representatives who report in words and pictures may be present at the tournaments.
- Decisions of the tournament management are final.
