


Black Jack is the casino version of the card game 21.

The aim of the game is to score more points with your cards than the house – but no more than 21.

## What do you play with?

Players do not play with cash but with chips which they can exchange at the cash desk or the gaming table. There is a minimum and a maximum stake that may vary depending on the table.



## Know how: How to play correctly



After all players have made their bets, the dealer draws the cards, face up. Starting with one for each box, then one for the house, followed by another card for each box.

If there is no Black Jack (a combination of ace and 10 or ace and a face card) you can ask for more cards to improve your total. Finally, the dealer draws further cards for the house, until he reaches at least 17 points.

## Winnings



You receive 1.5 times your bet for each Black Jack. The players counting up more points than the house will be paid 1:1. In a draw your bet remains (a so called stand-off).

#### Probability of winning

Black Jack is not only easy to play, it also offers excellent chances. Depending on the strategy of playing, you can achieve a pay-off rate of up to 99%.

#### This is how it works

The dealer will then continue to take cards for the house until they have a total of 17 or higher. With the goal to reach 21, the players continue to draw cards, card for card. They continue receiving cards until they say that they do not wish any more. If the total is over 21 the hand is bust, the player's bet is taken by the house and the turn to act passes to the next player.

Six box owners can play against the bank with Black Jack. Other guests have the possibility, to also bet on the box. However, only the box owner can decide whether he wants further cards dealt or to stop.



## Pairs: an additional chance

A Pair is an additional chance to win at Black Jack. If the first two cards in your box are a pair, then you have already won.





Any Pair Red and black card with the same value. Winnings:

6 times your bet.





## Prime Pair

A pair of red or black cards with different suits and same value. Winnings: 12 times your bet.





## **Suited Pair**

Two identical cards. Winnings: 25 times your bet.





## Super Pair

Two times ace of hearts. Winnings: 100 times your bet. Blazing 7's: The supplementary bet



The supplementary bet, Blazing 7's, is a jackpot bet. The bet value is always 2.50 Euros. Before the cards are dealt, the 2.50 Euros are placed on a sensor to register the player's additional bet. The guests have the possibility to bet, that with their first two or three cards, a combination of

various cards, have a total value of 7. The combinations below have the following pay outs.
These are additional winnings.




One 7: (only the first two cards)
Winnings: 5 Euros



Two 7s (only the first two cards)

Winnings: 50 Euros

**Three 7s** (only the first three cards) Winnings: 500 Euros



Three 7s same colour

Winnings: 100 % of Minor Jackpot

Envy Bonus: 50 Euros



Three 7s all suited (but not diamond)

Winnings: 100% of Major Jackpot

Envy Bonus: 100 Euros



Three 7s diamond

Winnings: 100 % of Mega Jackpot

Envy Bonus: 500 Euros

Counts as 1 or 11





Face card always
