The game with numbers and colours

At the roulette table, everything is about the ball. That means, you are betting that the ball is falling into the numbered compartment that you have chosen.


What do you play with?

Players do not play with cash but with chips which they can exchange at the cash desk or the gaming table. There is a minimum and a maximum stake that may vary depending on the table.



Know how:

How to play correctly



37 numbers (0 to 36) are arranged on the tableau and on the wheel.

The croupier starts each round by saying “place your bets”. Now you can place your chips on the gaming table. If there are chips already lying on a number field, place your chips on top of the others.

Wheel Checks – The colourful alternative

If you like, you can play American Roulette with wheel checks (coloured chips). Before your first game, you determine the value of your chip yourself. Unlike normal chips, which are treated like currency, wheel checks do not have a fixed value printed on them. Instead they are distinguishable by their colour.

Your chosen colour remains reserved for as long as you are at the table and participate in the game.





- 1. Straight Up** / 1 number /
35 x your bet*
- 2. Split** / 2 numbers / 17 x bet*
- 3. Street** / 3 numbers / 11 x bet*
- 4. Corner** / 4 numbers / 8 x bet*
- 5. Six line** / 6 numbers / 5 x bet*
- 6. Douzaine** / 12 numbers / 2x bet* /
Example: 1-12, 13-24, 25-36
- 7. Column** / 12 numbers / 2x bet* /
Example: 3-36
- 8. Odd or even, red or black, 1-18 or 19-36**
18 numbers / 1 x bet*

Race track to get lucky



Another unique way that distinguishes American Roulette is the race track. The race track is a separate area, situated beside to the main roulette layout. It is a separate layout where the croupier sets neighbouring numbers for you; series and neighbouring numbers. That means, if you have two neighbouring numbers to the left and right of the 23, you let the croupier place five chips on the 23 for you.



6 numbers / 5 x bet*
6. **Douzaine** / 12 numbers /
2 x bet*
7. **Colonne** / 12 numbers / 2 x bet*
8. **Red or black, pair or impair,
Passe or Manque** /
18 numbers / 1 x bet*



*Chances of winning

Chances of winning



1. Plein

$1/37 = 2,7\%$

2. Cheval

$2/37 = 5,41\%$

3. Transversale pleine

$3/37 = 8,11\%$

4. Carré and the first four

$4/37 = 10,81\%$

5. Transversale simple

$6/37 = 16,22\%$

6./7. Colonne and Douzaine

$12/37 = 32,43\%$

8. Simple chances

$18/37 = 48,65\%$

Probability of winning



Hard to believe but it's true. The pay out odds with Roulette are higher than you would think. Whether you are playing French Roulette or American Roulette, an average of 97.3 % of bets is paid out to the winners.
